The Ukrainian-born artist Zoya Cherkassky presents a new series of paintings and drawings that explores ordinary moments, like cooking, through the lens of someone living in a place that feels familiar yet different. Her paintings are vibrant, full of colour, and littered with dry humour throughout. Cherkassky moved to Israel after the collapse of the Soviet Union. She also left Israel in the aftermath of the October 7 attacks in 2023. Now residing in Long Island, New York, her work mirrors her adjustment to living in the United States.
